## **Statement of Intent**

This policy sets out the management framework for the delivery of boarding and welfare provision within Buckswood School.

Ms. Jenny O'Shea, Head of Boarding oversees the development of boarding. Weekly meetings take place each Friday in order to reflect upon the previous week, prepare for the upcoming one and discuss student feedback.

The Head of Boarding has overall responsibility for boarding at Buckswood School, leads its development and has meetings with the staff involved as appropriate in addition to their weekly scheduled meetings.

The Head of boarding and Designated Safeguarding Lead work as a partnership to identify any training requirements and develop training plans for House Staff members in order to assure all government standards are met.

The House mistresses/masters are responsible for the day-to-day running of their Houses in accordance with duties assigned.
