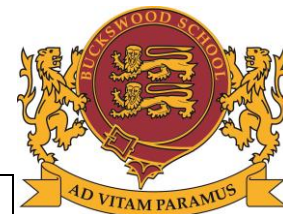


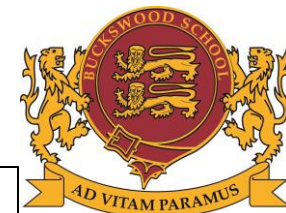

You'll be getting better at writing about events chronologically to explain the causes and consequences of events. Visiting the battlefield and meeting a Saxon!	Football and Plague! What was medieval England like for different sorts of people? We'll be finding out about life in a medieval village and town; medieval sport, entertainment and fashion; life for women in the middle ages; religious beliefs; fun to be a nun; keeping law and order; punishment; the Black Death; revolting peasants! We'll be getting better at describing and understanding the characteristics of life during the middle ages. Visiting medieval Winchelsea and Rye.	Power and Murder! We'll be finding out about the feudal system; the conflict between the King and Church; the murder of Thomas Becket Church role of the Church; Crusades; King John – Magna Carta man; how bad King John really was; how England dealt with its neighbours – Wales, Scotland, Ireland and France; Joan of Arc - the young woman who led an army; Richard vs Henry - the triumph of the Tudors; Medieval Britain - what changed? We'll be getting better at solving history mystery, the murder of the princes in the Tower, and talking and writing about change. Visiting the Tower of London.
