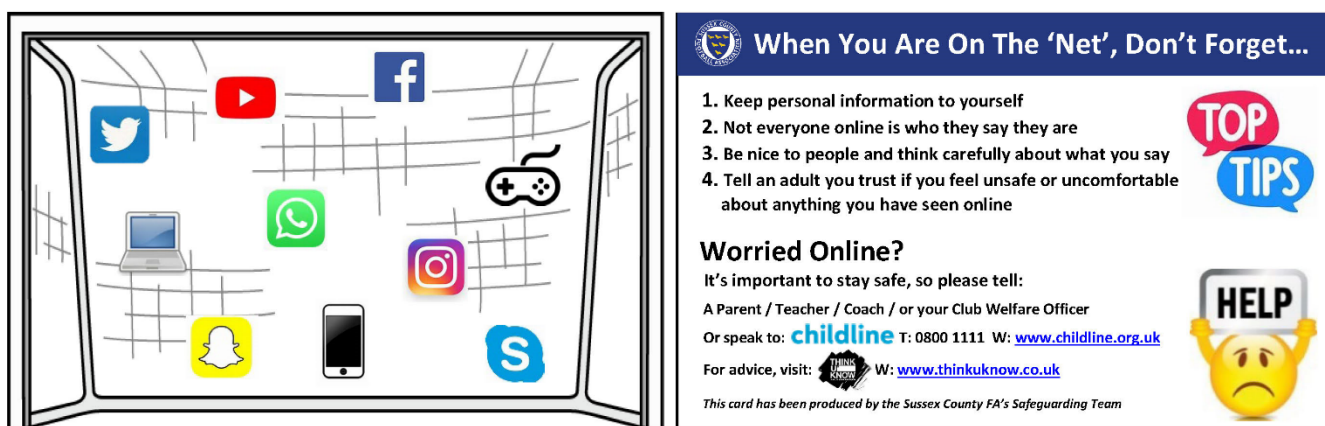


Support for Parents and Students on On-Line Safety
